

Central City High School - After Prom Rules

- After-Prom is held at Central City Performance Art Center and Middle School. Attendees that leave the school premises after prom must enter through the “PAC” entrance and resubmit to breathalyzer testing. Attendees that change/stay at the high school will be allowed to bypass the breathalyzer testing. All attendees will register with the After Prom check-in table and enter the “PAC”. Check in begins at 12:15 am and ends at 12:45 am. Attendees arriving after 12:45 am will not be admitted. Phone calls to inform parents/guardians will be made for those not reporting. The After-Prom event ends after the Grand Prize(s) presentation at 4:00 am Sunday morning.
- No alcohol, drugs or tobacco products are allowed and will not be tolerated.
- All CCHS Juniors and Seniors are invited to attend and are welcome, even if they decide not to attend the CCHS Prom. Each student is allowed to bring a guest.
- Each student and their guest are required to sign a release waiver in order to participate in the fun of After-Prom. All minors must have a parental signature. Admission/Permission must be turned in to the High School office by April 8th. Registration cost is \$12.00 per person.
- Tickets are all inclusive! Snacks, food, drinks, inflatables, games and any and all activities are included in the price of the ticket! Attendees will also receive a t-shirt. Students do not need any additional money.
- Dress casually and wear tennis shoes since a lot of activities will take place in the gym. No dress shoes, high heels or black soled shoes may be worn in the gym. Socks or bare feet are acceptable.
- Each After-Prom (CCHS Senior & Junior) attendee will be given a raffle ticket at the registration table. They may enter their raffle ticket in one of the grand prizes of their choice for a random drawing. Students must be in attendance to claim prizes. If they leave the event and their name is drawn, it will be withdrawn and another name will be selected. The drawing of the Grand Prizes begins at 4:00 am.
- Each After-Prom (CCHS Senior & Junior) attendee will have an opportunity to win a prize throughout the evening. Attendees (CCHS Seniors & Juniors) have the option of playing a one round of “Plinko” (or another game designated by the After-Prom Committee) anytime between 2:15 -3:30 am. Once the game is closed, their names are entered in a random drawing for remaining prizes. Students must be in attendance to claim prizes. If they leave the event and their name is drawn, it will be withdrawn and another name will be selected. All prizes will be set aside for in a bag for each student to collect after the Grand Prize announcements.
- After Prom is NOT a lock in. Students and their guests may leave any time they choose, however, they will not be allowed to re-enter once they have left. They will be asked to sign out with the time noted behind their signature. Phone calls to inform parents/guardians will be made informing them their student chose to leave After-Prom early. Parental authorization may be sent in prior to After-Prom stating when their student may leave. All parental authorizations will be double checked with a phone call. Students will forfeit any prizes if they choose to leave.
- Students must stay in the areas designated for activities. Student caught roaming other areas of the building will be asked to rejoin the activities. The second offense may result in the attendees being asked to leave.
- Students must obey the “CCHS” rules of conduct.
- All attendees will be dismissed following the Grand Prize(s) distribution.
